30 Years of Impact: About You Have The Power

For 30 years, You Have The Power (YHTP) has brought together those affected by violence. You Have The Power's mission is to empower those victimized by violent crime through information, advocacy, and understanding. Our work includes:

- Producing essential resource guides on topics such as child abuse, domestic violence, online safety, etc.
- Producing and facilitating curriculums for businesses, youth, and incarcerated individuals.
- Coordinated the renewal of the Children's Memory Garden of Nashville.





About the Children's Memory Garden of Nashville



In 2016, You Have the Power collaborated with Metro Departments and victim advocates to upgrade the Children's Memory Garden in Centennial Park. The Garden, dedicated in 1996, was a place of comfort for families who lost a child to violence.

The work of the Children's Memory Garden group resulted in plans for a professionally designed new garden and a concept, Voices from the Garden, to tell the stories of children taken by violence. Voices from the Garden, an annual volume prepared by You Have the Power, includes the child's photo and profile, much like a yearbook these children never had. You Have The Power has also dedicated a website as a digital memoir of all the children in Voices from the Garden at <https://childrensmemorygarden.org>.

About the Breakfast Program

The purpose of this breakfast is to honor the lives and help tell the stories of the innocent children in Davidson County who have lost their lives to violence. We hope to raise awareness and help people connect with the Children's Memory Garden, Voices from the Garden, and You Have The Power.



The funds raised through this event will continue to support the Children's Memory Garden, further the Youth Impact curriculum, and support YHTP's efforts to focus on issues affecting our communities. YHTP will use these funds to prioritize issues concerning gun safety, fentanyl, and abuse.

Why We Advocate



In an average year, 1,404 people die by guns in Tennessee. With a rate of 20.2 deaths per 100,000 people, Tennessee has the 12th highest rate of gun homicides in the United States.



In 2022, 20 victims of domestic violence lost their lives to homicide in Nashville, which was the deadliest recorded year in over a decade.



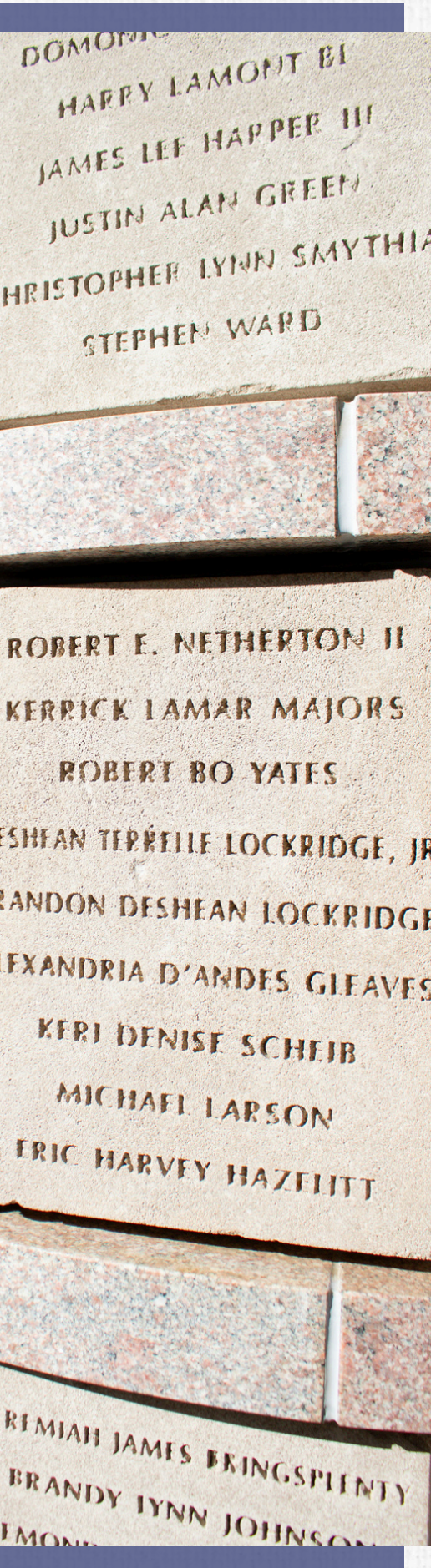
There is a 1-in-8 chance a child in Tennessee will become a victim of child abuse by the time they reach adulthood.



In 2022, there were 1,291 human trafficking hotline referrals made in Tennessee, with 361 of those being in Middle Tennessee.



In 2022, there were 3,826 deaths from drug overdoses in Tennessee, with the most prevalent drug types causing these deaths being opioids and fentanyl.
